



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF
FOOTPATHS MST 16 & MLS 25 STONEHOUSE & LEONARD STANLEY
(STONEHOUSE TOWN & LEONARD STANLEY PARISH) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council intend to make an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) Public Footpath MST 16 in the Town of Stonehouse from its junction with Public Footpath MST 13 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 79717/05074 extending in a generally South easterly direction for approximately 220 metres to OSGR SO 79626/04879 (Point B) and then carrying on along MLS 25 in the parish of Leonard Stanley for approximately a further 400 metres in a South easterly direction to its junction with Public Footpath MLS 1 at OSGR SO 79350/04648 and shown on the Order Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B to C.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the public whilst gas main replacement works take place.

The Order will come into force on the 21st September 2020 and it is anticipated that the footpath will close on that day until 11th December 2020. However, the Order can permit the closure of the Footpath for up to six months from the date of the initial closure. After this date if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.

There is no alternative route.

Pedestrian access to properties and emergency access will be maintained for the duration of the works.
