

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF  
PUBLIC FOOTPATHS MST 13, MCA 17 & MCA 18  
(STONEHOUSE AND CAINSCROSS TOWNS) STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2022**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for Public Footpath MST 13 from its junction with MST 12 in a generally easterly direction for approximately 3.1 kilometres and then continuing as MCA 17 in a generally easterly direction for 270 metres before continuing as MCA 18 in an easterly direction for 790 metres to its junction with MCA 11 ("the Footpath") is satisfied that use of the Footpath should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

**CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November Two Thousand and Twenty Two and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months;
2. This Order may be cited as the "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public Footpaths MST 13, MCA 17 & MCA 18 (Stonehouse and Cainscross Towns) Stroud District Order 2022";

**GENERAL**

3. Except for emergency and pedestrian access to premises no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath;
4. The Restricted Byway and Footpath fall in Rodborough Parish and Stroud Town in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire.
