



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS MST 2**  
**(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT**

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council has made an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) part of Public Footpath MST 2 from its junction with Public Footpath MST 4 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 80035/06263 extending in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 170 metres to its junction with Public Footpath (former) MST 2 at OSGR SO 80128 06384 and shown on the Order Map by a bold solid black line marked A to B.

The Public Footpath falls in the town of Stonehouse in the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire.

The closure is necessary to safeguard the public whilst construction works takes place.

The Order came into force on the 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022 and it was expected that the Public Footpath would close on that day until 18<sup>th</sup> June 2023. However, as works are still ongoing, the Secretary of State has granted an extension of the Order until 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023, or until the completion of the works, whichever is the earlier.
