

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER
C209 OLDENDS LANE (STONEHOUSE TOWN)
STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2023

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for C209 Oldends Lane road from its junction with Brunel Way to its junction with the Football Club entrance for a total distance of approximately 250 metres ("the Road") is satisfied that use of the Road should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Road;
2. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Road
3. The Road falls in the Town of Stonehouse within the Stroud District and in the County of Gloucestershire;
4. This Order shall come into operation on the 14th day of August Two Thousand and Twenty-Three and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months;
5. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order C209 Oldends Lane (Stonehouse Town) Stroud District Order 2023".
6. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.


