

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ORDER
BRISTOL ROAD & DOWNTON ROAD AND FOOTWAY(STONEHOUSE TOWN)
STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2023

WHEREAS Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for Bristol Road & Downton Road and Footway from its junction with Boakers Drive to its junction with Horsethrough Roundabout for a total distance of approximately 1000 metres ("the Roads") is satisfied that use of the Roads should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed nor cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the Roads;
2. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes to proceed along the Roads
3. Nothing in Article 1 above shall render it unlawful for a vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker responding to an emergency situation to proceed along the Roads;
4. The Roads are within the town of Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of August Two Thousand and Twenty Three and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months;
6. This Order may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Traffic Order Bristol Road and Downton Road and Footway) (Stonehouse Town) Stroud District Order 2023".
7. In the event of any inconsistency or ambiguity between the content of this Temporary Order and any existing permanent/experimental Order(s) imposing restriction(s) on the Road or diversion routes the latter will be suspended for the duration of the works and the provisions of this Temporary Order shall prevail during that period.
