

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH MST 62**  
**(STONEHOUSE TOWN)**  
**STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2023**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council (“the Council”) being the Traffic Authority for part of Public Footpath MST 62, Stonehouse, from its junction with Public Footpath MST 27 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 81118/05068 and then extending in a generally north easterly and northerly direction for approximately 335 metres to its junction with Public Footpath MST 30 at OSGR SO 81207/05353. (“the Footpath”) is satisfied that use of the Footpath should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

**CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of October Two Thousand and Twenty Three and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months;
2. This Order may be cited as “Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure Of Public Footpath MST 62 (Stonehouse Town) Stroud District Order 2023”;

**GENERAL**

3. Except for pedestrian access to adjacent properties, no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath;
4. The Footpath falls in Stonehouse Town in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire
