



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH MST 62
(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that Gloucestershire County Council has made an Order to close temporarily under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 (as amended) Public Footpath MST 62, Stonehouse, from its junction with Public Footpath MST 27 at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SO 81118/05068 and then extends in a generally north easterly and northerly direction for approximately 335 metres to its junction with Public Footpath MST 30 at OSGR SO 81207/05353.

The closure is necessary to protect the public while urgent works are carried out on the footpath.

The Order will come into force on the 24th October 2023 and it is anticipated that the footpath will close on that day and remain closed until 15th November 2023. However, the Order can permit the closure of the Footpath for up to six months from the date of the initial closure. After this date if the closure is still required it will be necessary to apply to the Secretary of State for an extension of time.

Alternative Route - as signed on site

Pedestrian access to properties and emergency access will not be maintained for safety reasons.
