



**EMERGENCY ROAD CLOSURE C208 REGENT STREET
(STONEHOUSE TOWN) STROUD DISTRICT**

Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority, has, by this emergency notice, closed temporarily, under the relevant provisions of Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of the C208 Regent Street from outside the property known as No. 52 Regent Street to the bottom of the Cul-de-sac for an approximate distance of 50 metres ("the Road")

The Road falls in the Town of Stonehouse in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire.

The reason for the closure is to ensure public safety whilst repairs are undertaken to a collapsed wall.

This Notice comes into force on the **24th November 2023** and may continue in force for up to 21 days. If the works to remedy the problem have not been completed within the 21 days allowed for in this Notice, it will be necessary to either extend the closure by another Notice, for a further 21 days, or make a Temporary Road Closure Order. If necessary, this Order could authorise the closure of the Road for up to eighteen months from the date of this Notice.

Pedestrian access and emergency access will be maintained.

Alternative Route – N/A due to being dead end road.
