



URGENT ROAD CLOSURE 401185 OXLYNCH LANE (STANDISH PARISH) STROUD DISTRICT

Gloucestershire County Council, as traffic authority has, by this Notice, closed, temporarily, under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) part of 401185 Oxlynch Lane, from its junction with B4008 Standish to Gloucester Road to outside the property known as 'The Kings' for a distance of approximately 250 metres ("the Road")

The Road falls within the Parish of Standish in the Stroud District within the County of Gloucestershire.

The reason for the said closure is for safety during urgent pole replacement works in a narrow lane.

This Notice comes into force **on 21st December 2023**, and will continue for up to 5 days. However, if the works to remedy the problem have not been completed during this time scale it will be necessary to make an Order. This Order, if made, can authorise the closure of the Road for up to eighteen months from the date of this Notice.

Emergency and Pedestrian access will be maintained.
